We had such great response last year at our combined show with the Quarter horse club we decided to have two combined shows this year. We are gathering some great prizes to give away. Dear Friends,

I hope all of you are looking forward to decent horse weather as much as we on the board are! This year we hope to have better participation in our shows, and we have offered some great schooling shows where you can dress down and relax. As always we need to be aware of our budget, and this year it is especially concerning. Due to large expenses and less than stellar income last season our reserve is critically low.

The board has been busy trying to think of ways to generate funds. We as always, depend heavily on sponsors from the business community, but this year we are requesting more help from our members. We would like all members to find at least one sponsor. For those members who are unable to find a full sponsor, (Silver-\$100, Gold-\$250, Corporate-\$400). These contributors will get website exposure, publicity and recognition at the shows, preference for class sponsorship, and tickets for the season raffle. We are also offering a Bronze sponsorship for \$50. and Friends of the Paint Horse \$25. We appreciate all donations and will also accept smaller donations for other awards and club activities. These people would receive some tickets for the silent auction at the year end Awards Banquet, and have their names posted on the Club website as Friends and supporters of our shows and the year end awards.

We also have some ideas for more fund raising, such as a season long raffle for a portable Hot Wash. It holds 8 gal of water and has a thermostat that can be set form 65 to 165 degrees and comes with a folding cart for easy transport. It runs on regular outlet 110v , or a generator and heats in 20 min.. It is great for vetting emergencies, shows or camping.

If there is sufficient interest we may host a summer evening local trail ride and picnic. This would be a fun family event and club social and could generate some funds if we had some volunteer cooks and food donations.

This can be a wonderful year with great awards but we need your support and donations. Please help this be one of our most fun and productive years ever!
